

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAW AND SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

Notice is given, according to section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of October 22, 2018:

04-047-197 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)

This by-law amends the city's planning program with respect to the map titled "Building density" for the Anjou borough in order to include the new 02-10 sector in the Avenue Chaumont area, allowing buildings with 2 to 4 aboveground storeys and a medium to high site coverage ratio. (CM18 1285)

Following the public notice published on October 29, 2018, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), by-law 04-047-197 is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of November 29, 2018 and comes into force on that date.
