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Notice is given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of February 13, 2019:

**Ordonnance fixant la rémunération du président du Comité Jacques-Viger (3)**

**Ordonnance fixant la rémunération des membres du Comité Jacques-Viger (4)**

These ordinances, adopted under article 23 of the By-law concerning the Comité Jacques-Viger (12-022), set the remuneration of the chair and members of the committee and replace ordinance 2 regarding the same matter.

**Ordonnance édictant la date d'entrée en vigueur de certaines dispositions du Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la Charte montréalaise des droits et responsabilités et sur le droit d'initiative (05-056-5) (1)**

This ordinance, adopted under article 7 of by-law 05-056-5, amending the By-law concerning the Montréal Charter of Rights and Responsibilities and the Right of Initiative, sets the date of February 25, 2019, for the coming into force of the provisions allowing the exercise of the right of initiative online.

**Ordonnance visant à modifier la date de recevabilité de demandes de subvention (2)**

This ordinance, adopted under articles 18, 19 and 20 of the By-law concerning subsidies for the alteration of the electrical service connection of certain buildings (R.B.C.M., chapter S-6.01) modifies the date of admissibility for subsidy applications regarding projects on Rue Saint-Patrick, Rue Saint-Grégoire and Chemin de la Côte-Saint-Luc.
