

PUBLIC NOTICE COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-law was adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of January 31, 2019:

RCG 19-002 Règlement autorisant un emprunt de 300 000 \$ afin de financer les travaux de réfection requis pour la mise aux normes des écocentres existants, un emprunt de 1 935 000 \$ pour financer l'achat d'équipements servant à l'échantillonnage des rejets industriels, pour l'acquisition et l'installation d'équipements informatiques et électroniques, pour le remplacement d'instruments analytiques en fin de vie utile et pour l'ergonomie des postes de travail et un emprunt de 450 000 \$ pour financer la protection et la réfection de bâtiments des stations d'échantillonnage de la qualité de l'air

[By-law authorizing a loan of \$300,000 for repair work required for the bringing to standards of the existing ecocentres, a loan of \$1,935,000 for the purchase of equipment used for sampling industrial waste, for the acquisition and installation of computer and electronic equipment, for the replacement of analytical tools that have reached the end of their useful life and for the ergonomics of workstations, and a loan of \$450,000 for the protection and repair of buildings at the air quality sampling facilities]

This by-law was approved by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing on March 25, 2019. It comes into force on March 29, 2019, and may be consulted during regular business hours at the Service du greffe, 275, rue Notre-Dame Est (155, rue Notre-Dame Est as of April 29, 2019).
