## **ORDINANCE**

Notice is given that the following ordinance under article 59 of the By-law concerning domestic animals (18-042) was adopted at the executive committee meeting of April 10, 2019:

Ordonnance déterminant les conditions particulières de garde pour un chien qui n'a pas été déclaré potentiellement dangereux (2)

This ordinance establishes special conditions for a dog that has not been declared potentially dangerous: when, following an evaluation by the city expert, the authority having jurisdiction determines the degree of danger of a dog is low to moderate, the animal must be muzzled at all times when it is found outside of its guardian's occupancy unit.

This ordinance comes into force on April 16, 2019, and is available for consultation during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 275, rue Notre-Dame Est (155, rue Notre-Dame Est as of April 29, 2019) as well as online at www.ville.montreal.qc.ca/reglements.
