TO INTERESTED PERSONS HAVING THE RIGHT TO SIGN AN APPLICATION FOR THE APPROVAL
BY REFERENDUM

SECOND DRAFT BY-LAW NO. P.2098-LAS-194

1. PURPOSE OF THE DRAFT AND APPROVAL BY REFERENDUM

Following the public consultation meeting held on April 16, 2019, the Council has adopted second draft by-law P.2098-LAS-194 amending By-law No. 2098 to modify the applicable rules for swimming pools and spas.

The purpose of this by-law is to harmonize the borough by-law with the provincial norms and to modify the applicable rules for swimming pools and spas. It is also to transfer the section on pools and spas to the chapter on residential uses so that the standards apply only to residential pools and spas, in conformity with the provincial regulation.

This second draft contains provisions that could be the object of an application by interested persons in the entire territory and contiguous zones such that a by-law that contains them be submitted for their approval in conformity with The Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities.

2. CONDITIONS FOR A VALID APPLICATION

To be valid, an application must:

- Indicate clearly the provision being addressed and the zone from which it is submitted;
- be received at the office of the *Secrétaire d'arrondissement* no later than May 21, 2019, at 16:45;
- be signed by at least 12 interested persons from the zone from which the application is submitted, or at least the majority of them if the number of interested persons in the zone does not exceed 21.

3. INTERESTED PERSONS

Information required to determine who are the interested persons having the right to sign an application and the manner in which a legal person may exercise the right to sign an application may be obtained at the office of the *Secrétaire d'arrondissement*, 55 avenue Dupras, LaSalle, during business hours.

4. ABSENCE OF APPLICATIONS

All provisions of the second draft that are not subject to any valid application can be included in a by-law that will not require approval by eligible voters.

5. CONSULTATION OF THE DRAFT

The draft by-law may be consulted at the office of the *Secrétaire d'arrondissement*, located at 55 avenue Dupras, LaSalle, during business hours.
