

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAW AND SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

Notice is given, according to section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of March 25, 2019:

04-047-202 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)

This by-law replaces the land use designation for certain "mixed-use" areas with a "diversified activity area" use for neighborhoods surrounding the Turcot interchange, in Le Sud-Ouest borough (CM19 0362).

Following the public notice published on April 1, 2019, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), by-law 04-047-202 is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of May 2, 2019, and comes into force on that date.
