

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAW AND SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

Notice is given, according to section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of April 15, 2019:

04-047-201 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)

This by-law replaces the designation of the Hushion Bath in the list of buildings of heritage interest by "Ancien bain Hushion" (Former Hushion Bath) for the building located at 757, rue des Seigneurs, in Le Sud-Ouest borough (CM19 0470).

Following the public notice published on April 23, 2019, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), by-law 04-047-201 is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of May 24, 2019, and comes into force on that date.
