



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of June 20, 2019:

RCG 12-003-2 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le Service de sécurité incendie de Montréal (12-003)

[By-law amending the By-law concerning the Service de sécurité incendie de Montréal (RCG 12-003)]

The amendments namely require the installation of smoke alarms powered by a non-removable lithium battery with a 10-year lifespan in residential buildings, add details concerning the maintenance and good working order of alarms in buildings housing persons in need of assistance in case of evacuation and standardize the identification of fire-department connections.

RCG 19-021 Règlement autorisant la démolition de deux bâtiments ainsi que la construction et l'occupation, à des fins résidentielles, pour des personnes ayant besoin d'aide et d'hébergement, d'un bâtiment sur les lots 1 565 252 et 1 565 255 du cadastre du Québec

[By-law authorizing the demolition of two buildings as well as the construction and occupancy, for residential purposes, for persons in need of assistance and lodging, of a building on lots 1 565 252 and 1 565 255, cadastre of Québec]

RCG 19-022 Règlement autorisant la démolition du bâtiment situé sur le lot 2 162 004 du cadastre du Québec afin de permettre la construction et l'occupation d'un bâtiment à des fins résidentielles pour personnes ayant besoin d'aide et d'hébergement

[By-law authorizing the demolition of a building located on lot 2 162 004, cadastre of Québec, to allow the construction and occupancy of a building for residential purposes, for persons in need of assistance and lodging]
