

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

Notice is given that the draft by-law titled "By-law amending the By-law concerning the remuneration of council members (02-039)" was presented at the city council meeting of June 17, 2019, and that a notice of motion was given for its adoption at a subsequent city council meeting.

The draft by-law introduces a supplementary remuneration to be paid to members of city council to compensate them for a decrease in revenue resulting from their expense allowance now being subject to income tax at the federal level. The supplementary remuneration will be equivalent to the amount required to set off any income tax payable on the expense allowance and the supplementary remuneration, considering only revenues received for positions held as a municipal elected official. The by-law will have retroactive effect as of January 1, 2019. For 2019, the amount of the supplementary remuneration will vary between \$5,777 and \$10,745 according to the total remuneration paid to the council member and the applicable tax rate.

This draft by-law will be listed for adoption by city council at its regular meeting of Monday, August 19, 2019, at 1 p.m., in the council chamber of the Lucien-Saulnier building, located at 155, rue Notre-Dame Est (Champ-de-Mars metro station). Please note that a public question period is scheduled at 7 p.m.
