

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAW AND SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

Notice is given, according to section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of June 17, 2019:

04-047-203 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047) This by-law amends the list of buildings of heritage and architectural interest located outside areas of exceptional value for Ville-Marie borough by removing the immovable located at 330, rue Christin (Riga Apartments) (CM19 0786).

Following the public notice published on June 26, 2019, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), by-law 04-047-203 is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of July 27, 2019, and comes into force on that date.
