Property Assessment Roll

Notice is given that the three-year property assessment roll of the Ville de Montréal, in effect on fiscal years 2020, 2021 and 2022, has been filed in my office on September 11, 2019.

It may be consulted at city hall, at points of service of the Ville de Montréal and at regional offices of the Service de l'évaluation foncière during regular office hours, or on Internet (montreal.ca).

Any person having an interest in contesting the correctness, existence or absence of an entry on the Roll relating to a unit of assessment, may file an application for administrative review in accordance with division I of chapter X of the *Act respecting municipal taxation* (CQLR, chapter F-2.1).

To be admissible, applications for administrative review must meet the following conditions:

- Be filed before May 1, 2020.
- Be submitted on the prescribed form, available at the addresses below and at any point of service of the Ville de Montréal.
- Include the amount under the *By-law concerning fees of the urban agglomeration of Montréal (Fiscal 2019)* (RCG 18-039), adopted by the urban agglomeration of Montréal council and applicable to the unit of assessment covered by the application.
- Be filed in person with the Service de l'évaluation foncière of the Ville de Montréal, at the addresses below, Monday through Thursday, from 8:30 a.m. to noon and 1 to 4:30 p.m. and on Friday until 4:00 p.m.:
