However, persons with reduced mobility may request the assistance of a security guard to go to the first floor. The draw determining the order in which citizens may ask their questions will take place 30 minutes before each meeting. It is imperative that citizens provide a picture ID for registration purposes. Failure to do so will prevent them from registering. Registered persons will receive an ID pass that will grant them access to the council chamber so that they may ask their question.

Persons registered for question period as well as persons wishing to attend council deliberations may access the Lucien-Saulnier building by using the main entrance (155, rue Notre-Dame Est).

The room is equipped with a hearing aid system that can be accessed by tuning in to 100.3 FM on your portable player. Moreover, an interpretation service for persons with a hearing impairment is available on request, subject to the availability of interpreters.
