# Public review of the 2020 budget and the 2020-2021-2022 three-year capital works program of Ville de Montréal, its paramunicpal bodies and the STM

The Commission sur les finances et l'administration invites you to take part in a public review of the 2020 operating budget and the 2020-2021-2022 three-year capital works program of Ville de Montréal, its paramunicpal bodies and the Société de transport de Montréal.

The public review will be held over 10 business days, from November 27 to December 10, 2019, between 9 a.m. and 10 p.m. A detailed schedule of the presentations (in French only) is available at ville.montreal.gc.ca/etudebudget2020.

#### LOCATION

All sessions will take place in the council chamber of city hall on the 2nd floor of the Lucien-Saulnier building, located at 155 Rue Notre-Dame Est (Champ-de-Mars metro).

#### CONDUCT OF MEETINGS

The business units and paramunicipal bodies will take turns presenting their 2020 operating budget and 2020-2021-2022 three-year capital works program. Each presentation will be followed by a public question period and a question period for committee members.

The committee will then develop its recommendations during in-camera working sessions. The public session to adopt the recommendations will be held on December 10, 2019, at 5:30 p.m., in the council chamber of city hall.
