Notice is given that **special meeting** of the urban agglomeration council will be held as follows:

(Champ-de-Mars metro station)

The special meeting of **December 13, 2019**, will pertain to the adoption of the city's three-year capital works program (urban agglomeration component) for 2020-2021-2022, the 2020 budget (urban agglomeration component), the approbation of the capital works program for 2020-2029 of the Société de transport de Montréal and the approbation of the 2020 budgets of certain paramunicipal agencies.

Please note that the question period and council deliberations during the special meeting will pertain exclusively to the above-mentioned topics, in accordance with Section 474.2 of the Cities and Towns Act.

A public question period will be held at the beginning of this special meeting. Anyone wishing to ask questions must obtain a registration number, one hour before the start of the meeting, **on the first floor of the Lucien-Saulnier building (Hall of Honour), located at 155, rue Notre-Dame Est**. However, persons with reduced mobility may request the assistance of a security guard to go to the first floor. The draw determining the order in which citizens may ask their questions will take place 30 minutes before this meeting. It is imperative that citizens provide a picture ID for registration purposes. Failure to do so will prevent them from registering. Registered persons will receive an ID pass that will grant them access to the council chamber so that they may ask their question.

Persons registered for question period as well as persons wishing to attend council deliberations may access the Lucien-Saulnier building by using the main entrance (155, rue Notre-Dame Est).

The room is equipped with a hearing aid system that may be accessed by tuning in to 100.3 FM on your portable player. Moreover, an interpretation service for persons with a hearing impairment is available on request, subject to the availability of interpreters. Kindly contact 514-872-3142, at least three business days prior to the meeting.
