ORDINANCES

Notice is given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of January 22, 2020:

Ordonnance relative aux documents intitulés « Fiche bâtiment / déclaration de conformité » et « Fiche toit végétalisé » (3)

This *ordinance* relating to the documents titled “fiche bâtiment / déclaration de conformité” and “fiche toit végétalisé” (building specification / statement of compliance form and vegetative roof form), adopted under articles 34 and 35 of the By-law concerning the construction and conversion of buildings (11-018), replaces Ordinance No.2 enacted on October 17, 2012 as well as the documents approved thereunder.

Ordonnance émise relativement aux tarifs du Service BIXI pour la saison 2020 (1)

This ordinance relating to BIXI bike service fees for the 2020 season, adopted under article 68 of the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2020) (19-057), amends the fees for BIXI bike service subscribers, occasional users and OPUS cardholders set out in articles 60, 61, 63, 65 and 67.

Ordonnance adoptée dans le cadre de l'événement « Les plantes étranges de Mme Z » – réduction des tarifs des droits d'entrée au Jardin botanique (2)

This ordinance, adopted under article 119 of the By-law concerning fees (fiscal 2020) (19-057), reduces the regular rate and Québec resident rate of any ticket for admission to the Botanical Garden for the “Odd Plants of Mrs Z” exhibition purchased using the online ticketing service from February 1 to 25, 2020.

Ordonnance émise afin de désigner le secteur « Sainte-Catherine Ouest et ses abords » aux fins de l'application du règlement (2)

This ordinance, adopted under article 4 of the By-law concerning subsidies for the revitalization of Rue Sainte-Catherine and its surroundings (Programme Réussir@Montréal – Sainte-Catherine) (RCG 17-023), was issued to designate the “Sainte-Catherine Ouest and its surroundings” sector in the schedule for the purposes of the by-law as of February 1, 2020, for a 12-month period.

All these ordinances come into force on January 29, 2020, and are available for consultation during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est, as well as online at www.ville.montreal.qc.ca/reglements.
