



## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

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Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of January 27, 2020:

**14-036-2** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention municipale à la rénovation et à la démolition-reconstruction résidentielles (14-036)**  
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the municipal subsidy for residential renovation and demolition-reconstruction (14-036)]

**14-037-3** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention municipale à la rénovation résidentielle pour la réalisation de travaux ciblés (14-037)**  
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the municipal subsidy for residential renovation for targeted work (14-037)]

**14-038-1** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention municipale à la stabilisation des fondations des bâtiments résidentiels (14-038)**  
[By-law amending the By-law concerning municipal subsidies for the stabilization of foundations of residential buildings (14-038)]

The purpose of the three above-mentioned by-laws is to specify that a building's eligibility for the subsidy is based on its value entered on the 2017-2019 property assessment roll instead of the value on the 2020-2022 roll.

**08-055-8** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement du conseil de la Ville sur la délégation de certains pouvoirs relatifs au réseau de voirie artérielle aux conseils d'arrondissements (08-055)**  
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the delegation to borough councils of certain powers relating to the arterial road system (08-055)]  
The amendment provides for an exception to the delegation of powers to borough councils regarding the establishment of lanes reserved for certain vehicle types.
