

## MINOR EXEMPTIONS $N^{OS}$ DM 3001788154, DM 3001773974, DM 3001777695 ET DM 3001736235

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that at its regular sitting that will be held on March 9, 2020 at 7 p.m., in the council room, located at 13665, boulevard de Pierrefonds, the Borough Council will render a decision on the requests for minor exemption to urban planning by-laws for the following immovables:

**Study** Place of exemption DM 3001788154 4846, rue Millette

Allow in residential H3-7-415 zone, for a projected building, a front setback of 5 m instead of the required minimum of 6 m.

**Study** Place of exemption DM 3001773974 6016, rue Hunter

Allow in residential H1-6-353 zone, for an existing multifamily building, a rear setback inferior to the required minimum of 7 m, namely 5.15 m.

**Study** Place of exemption DM 3001777695 12718, rue Hunter

Allow in residential H1-6-353 zone, for an existing multifamily building, a rear setback inferior to the required minimum of 7 m, namely 6.5 m.

**Study** Place of exemption DM 3001736235 54, 11° Avenue

Allow in residential H1-7-442 zone, for an existing single-family dwelling:

- side setbacks inferior to the required minimum of 2 m, namely 1.95 m on north side and 1.89 m on south side;
- a building extension whose open space ratio will be of 0.35 m instead of the permitted maximum of 0.30 m.

NOTICE is also given that all interested parties may express their concerns to the Borough Council during the sitting regarding these requests.
