TO INTERESTED PERSONS HAVING THE RIGHT TO SIGN AN APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL BY REFERENDUM

SECOND DRAFT BY-LAW NO. P.2098-LAS-197

1. PURPOSE OF THE DRAFT AND APPROVAL BY REFERENDUM

Following the public consultation meeting held on January 28, 2020, Council has adopted second draft by-law P.2098-LAS-197 amending By-law no. 2098 to authorize retail stores of second-hand goods in certain zones and to prohibit flea markets and pawnshops throughout the borough.

The purpose of this second draft by-law is to authorize the retail stores of second-hand goods in 44 new areas and to exclude the uses "flea markets" and "pawnbrokers" throughout the territory of the borough.

This second draft contains provisions that could be the object of an application by interested persons in the zone concerned and contiguous zones such that a resolution that contains them be submitted for their approval in conformity with *The Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities*.

An application relative to these provisions may originate from concerned zones and from contiguous zones of the borough, as well as from contiguous zones of the boroughs Le Sud-Ouest and Lachine.

An application relating to these provisions shall require that this by-law be submitted to the approval of the qualified voters in the zone to which it applies and the contiguous zones from which a valid application is submitted.

2. CONDITIONS FOR A VALID APPLICATION

To be valid, an application must:

- Indicate clearly the provision being addressed and the zone from which it is submitted;
- be received at the office of the borough secretary no later than 4:45 p.m. February 26, 2020;
- be signed by at least 12 interested persons from the zone from which the application is submitted, or at least the majority of them if the number of interested persons in the zone does not exceed 21.

3. INTERESTED PERSONS

Information required to determine who are the interested persons having the right to sign an application and the manner in which a legal person may exercise the right to sign an application may be obtained at the office of the borough secretary, 55 avenue Dupras, LaSalle, during business hours.

4. ABSENCE OF APPLICATIONS

All provisions of the second draft that are not subject to any valid application can be included in a by-law that will not require approval by eligible voters.

5. CONSULTATION OF THE DRAFT

The draft by-law may be consulted at the office of the borough secretary, located at 55 avenue Dupras, LaSalle, during business hours.
