

## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS AND SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

Notice is given, according to section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of February 24, 2020:

## 04-047-208 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)

The by-law amends the list of buildings of heritage and architectural interest located outside areas of exceptional value in Ville-Marie borough by removing the "2310, rue Sainte-Catherine Est" building from the "Places of worship" category and adding it to the "Residential buildings" category".

Following the public notice published on March 2, 2020, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3S of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), by-law 04-047-208 is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of April 2, 2020, and comes into force on that date.
