COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of April 20, 2020:

- 20-012 Règlement autorisant l'occupation du bâtiment situé sur le lot 5 369 162 du cadastre du Québec à des fins d'hébergement pour personnes ayant besoin d'aide et d'assistance**
[By-law authorizing the occupancy of the building located on lot 5 369 162, cadastre of Québec, for housing purposes for persons in need of help and assistance]
- 20-014 Règlement sur la fermeture d'une ruelle située au nord-est de la 64^e Avenue, entre la 2^e Rue et la 3^e Rue, dans l'arrondissement de Rivière-des-Prairies–Pointe-aux-Trembles, aux fins de transfert aux propriétaires riverains**
[By-law to close a lane located northeast of 64^e Avenue, between 2^e Rue and 3^e Rue, in Rivière-des-Prairies–Pointe-aux-Trembles borough, for the purposes of transfer to bordering owners]
- 20-019 Règlement de contrôle intérimaire limitant les hauteurs et les densités dans l'arrondissement de Ville-Marie**
[Interim control by-law limiting heights and densities in Ville-Marie borough]
This by-law is adopted as part of adoption process of draft by-law P-04-047-207 which will amend the city's planning program by integrating the Des Faubourgs special planning program.
- 20-020 Règlement régissant les heures et les jours d'admission dans certains établissements commerciaux montréalais et dans les zones touristiques**
[By-law governing the opening hours and days of certain Montréal business establishments and in tourist areas]
This by-law allows exceptions to the opening hours and days under the Act respecting hours and days of admission to commercial establishments for businesses that mostly sell records and for those located in the downtown and Plateau-Mont-Royal tourist areas. The by-law gives the executive committee power to enact ordinances, namely to modify the tourist areas and categories of business covered by this by-law.

These by-laws come into force April 27, 2020 and may be consulted during regular business hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est. They are also available at www.ville.montreal.qc.ca/reglements.
