



## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

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**Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of April 23, 2020:**

- RCG 18-042-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le programme de subventions visant la revitalisation des secteurs commerciaux en chantier (RCG 18-042)**  
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the subsidy program for the revitalization of commercial areas under construction (RCG 18-042)]  
The amendments incorporate sustainable development requirements in order for work to be eligible for a subsidy. They also clarify certains aspects of the program.
- RCG 20-018 Règlement sur les subventions relatives aux bâtiments affectés à des activités économiques à finalité sociale (Accélérer l'investissement durable - Économie sociale)**  
[By-law concerning subsidies for buildings used for social economic activities (Accelerate sustainable investment - Social economy)]
- RCG 20-013-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement intérieur du conseil d'agglomération sur la délégation de pouvoirs du conseil d'agglomération au comité exécutif relatif à l'exercice du droit de préemption aux fins de logement social (RCG 20-013)**  
[By-law amending the Urban agglomeration council internal management by-law concerning the delegation of urban agglomeration council powers to the executive committee regarding the exercise of the city's pre-emptive right for social housing purposes (RCG 20-013)]  
The object is to take into account additional lots subjected to the city's pre-emptive right under resolution CG20 0216.
