ORDINANCES

Notice is given that the following ordinances were adopted at the executive committee meeting of July 8, 2020:

Ordonnance visant à établir et à modifier des voies de circulation à l'usage exclusif des autobus et de certaines autres catégories de véhicules (10)

This ordinance, adopted under article 3 of the By-law concerning traffic and parking (R.B.C.M., c. C-4.1), establishes and modifies reserved bus lanes and lanes for other vehicle categories. The modifications to some existing reserved lanes relate to their extension and hours of operation.

Ordonnance émise afin de désigner le secteur « Avenue du Mont-Royal » aux fins de l'application du règlement (17)

Ordonnance émise afin de désigner le secteur « Promenade Fleury » aux fins de l'application du règlement (18)

Ordinances 17 and 18 above are adopted under article 4 of the By-law concerning subsidies for the revitalization of commercial streets (Réussir@Montréal – commerce program) (RCG 15-082) and provide that the by-law applies to the designated sectors as follows:

- Avenue du Mont-Royal: As of July 15, 2020, for 109 days;
- Promenade Fleury: As of July 14, 2020, for 79 days.

Ordonnance visant à autoriser la consommation d'alcool sur le domaine public dans certains secteurs des arrondissements de Mercier-Hochelaga-Maisonneuve, du Plateau-Mont-Royal, de Rosemont-La Petite-Patrie, de Villeray-Saint-Michel-Parc-Extension, de Ville-Marie et du Sud-Ouest (6)

This ordinance, adopted under article 3 of the By-law concerning peace and order on public property (R.B.C.M., c. P-1), and authorizing liquor consumption on public property in certain sectors of Mercier-Hochelaga-Maisonneuve, Le Plateau-Mont-Royal, Rosemont-La Petite-Patrie, Villeray-Saint-Michel-Parc-Extension, Ville-Marie and Le Sud-Ouest boroughs, covers the period of July 13 to October 31, 2020.

All these ordinances come into force on July 13, 2020, and are available for consultation during regular office hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est, as well as online at www.ville.montreal.qc.ca/reglements.
