COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS AND SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

Notice is given, according to section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of May 25, 2020:

04-047-210 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047) afin d'assurer la concordance au Schéma d'aménagement et de développement de l'agglomération de Montréal The by-law amends the city's planning program for concordance purposes with respect to the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan. The amendments mainly affect two sectors in Lachine borough, that is, the Notre-Dame, Saint-Pierre and De la Berge-du-Canal industrial sector, as well as the Meadowbrook sector.

Following the public notice published on June 8, 2020, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), by-law 04-047-210 is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of July 9, 2020, and comes into force on that date.
