Notice is given to interested persons that due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Borough council of the Borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro has authorized, at the September 8, 2020 regular sitting, the replacement of the possibility for any interested person to be heard before the Council regarding a minor exemption request with a fifteen days written consultation, announced by a public notice, in accordance with ministerial order number 2020-049.

This written consultation concerns the minor exemption request for the following immovable:

The exemption is to allow in H4-3-135 zone, for a multifamily building (H3), a front setback of 7.73 m instead of the required minimum of 8.0 m.
