**DRAFT BY-LAW CONCERNING THE TAX CONCERNING SERVICES  
(2021 FISCAL YEAR)**

NOTICE is hereby given by the undersigned that a notice of motion will be tabled at the Borough Council meeting to be held at **7 p.m. on Monday, October 5, 2020**, for the purpose of adopting, at a subsequent meeting, the *By-law concerning the tax concerning services (2021 fiscal year)*.

Given the special circumstances due to the Covid-19 virus, the meeting will be held behind closed doors but will be webcast live on the borough Website.

THAT this draft by-law provides, as of the date it takes effect, that a special tax concerning services will be levied on the taxable value of any immovable entered on the property assessment roll and located in the borough, and that this rate may subsequently be adjusted.

THAT just as in 2020, the adoption of this by-law result in a transfer to the boroughs (special tax) of this portion of the fiscal space initially collected by the Ville de Montréal (general tax), so that boroughs can use this amount locally according to their needs and conditions.
