



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of September 24, 2020:

- RCG 20-031** **Règlement autorisant la démolition, la construction et l'occupation d'un bâtiment à des fins d'hébergement pour personnes ayant besoin d'aide et d'assistance situé sur le lot 1 294 166 du cadastre du Québec**
[By-law authorizing the demolition, construction and occupancy of a building on lot 1 294 166, cadastre of Québec, for purposes of housing persons in need of help and assistance]
- RCG 19-017-3** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement établissant le programme d'aide financière visant le développement de projets d'affaires d'entreprises montréalaises (RCG 19-017)**
[By-law amending the By-law establishing the financial assistance program concerning the development of business projects of Montréal businesses (RCG 19-017)]
The amendments increase the financial assistance amount available in 2020 for the “Social economy” subcategory and extend the easing of some support conditions put in place in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- RCG 20-033** **Règlement établissant le programme de subvention à l'innovation ouverte pour les entreprises émergentes**
[By-law establishing the open innovation subsidy program for emerging businesses]
- RCG 20-005-1** **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le programme de subventions relatif à la réhabilitation de terrains contaminés dans l'Est de Montréal (RCG 20-005)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the subsidy program for the rehabilitation of contaminated land in the East End of Montréal (RCG 20-005)]
In particular, the amendments add municipal bodies to the scope of the by-law, provide further details regarding documents required for the purposes of a subsidy application and harmonize certain provisions with those in the By-law concerning the subsidy program for the rehabilitation of contaminated land (19-022).

These by-laws come into force September 30, 2020, and may be consulted during regular business hours at the Service du greffe, 155, rue Notre-Dame Est. They are also available at www.ville.montreal.qc.ca/reglements.
