TO INTERESTED PERSONS HAVING THE RIGHT TO SIGN AN APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL BY REFERENDUM

SECOND DRAFT RESOLUTION NUMBER PP-23 (CA20 20 0383)

1. PURPOSE OF THE DRAFT AND APPROVAL BY REFERENDUM

Following the written public consultation held from September 10 to 26, 2020, the borough council adopted, at its regular sitting of October 5, 2020, a second draft resolution bearing no. PP-23 (CA20 20 0383) in conformity with the provisions of the *Bylaw concerning specific construction, alteration or occupancy proposals for an immovable* (LAS-0041).

The purpose of this particular project is to authorize the modification of certain standards relating to the maximum number of dwellings, the location and density of buildings and the number of parking spaces on lots 6389218 and 6389219 at the corner of Airlie and 80^e Avenue.

This second draft contains provisions that could be the object of an application by interested persons in the zone concerned and contiguous zones such that the resolution be submitted for their approval in conformity with *The Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities*.

An application relative to these provisions may originate from concerned zone C06-16 and from contiguous zones C05-15, C05-16, H05-17, H06-03, H06-14, H06-17 and I06-02.

An application relating to these provisions shall require that this resolution be submitted to the approval of the qualified voters in the zone to which it applies and to the contiguous zones from which a valid application is submitted.

2. CONDITIONS FOR A VALID APPLICATION

To be valid, an application must:

- indicate the resolution number PP-23 and the zone in which resides the applicant;
- indicate the name and the address of the applicant;
- be received by email at greffelasalle@montreal.ca no later than 4:45 p.m. on October 23, 2020;

3. INTERESTED PERSONS

Information required to determine who are the interested persons having the right to sign an application and the manner in which a legal person may exercise the right to sign an application may be obtained at the office of the Borough Secretary, by submitting a request to this effect by email at greffelasalle@montreal.ca.

4. ABSENCE OF APPLICATIONS

All provisions of the second draft that are not subject to any valid application can be included in a resolution that will not require approval by eligible voters.

5. DESCRIPTION OF THE ZONES AND CONSULTATION OF THE DRAFT

The draft resolution and the illustration of the concerned zone and the contiguous zones can be obtained from the office of the Borough Secretary, by submitting a request to this effect by email at greffelasalle@montreal.ca or by consulting the borough's website.
