## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of October 19, 2020:

- 09-007-3**      **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les commerces de prêt sur gages ou d'articles d'occasion (09-007)**  
[By-law amending the By-law concerning pawnshops and establishments dealing in second-hand goods (09-007)]  
The amendments apply specifically to the requirement for operators of businesses covered by the by-law to keep a register.
- 20-036**      **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention à la modification du raccordement du service électrique de certains bâtiments (S-6.01)**  
[By-law amending the By-law concerning subsidies for the alteration of the electrical service connection of certain buildings (S-6.01)]  
The by-law adds the Atlantic-Beaubien-Durocher-Hutchison sector and sets out the maximum subsidy amount applicable to the addresses in that sector. Schedules I and K are also amended to increase certain subsidy amounts, as well as to correct an address.
