COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the special urban agglomeration council meeting of November 12, 2020:

RCG 20-034 Règlement établissant le programme de subvention aux établissements situés dans un secteur traversé par le Réseau express vélo dans le contexte de la pandémie de COVID-19

[By-law establishing a COVID-19 subsidy program for businesses located in a sector impacted by the construction of the express bicycle network]

RCG 19-017-4 Règlement modifiant le Règlement établissant le programme d'aide financière visant le développement de projets d'affaires d'entreprises montréalaises (RCG 19-017)

[By-law amending the By-law establishing the financial assistance program concerning the development of business projects of Montréal businesses (RCG 19-017)]

The object of this by-law is specifically to increase the budget dedicated to the “commercial entrepreneurship” subcategory for 2020 and extend the easing of the conditions related to subsidies for the consolidation of retail business activities. The by-law also amends the executive committee’s ordinance power.
