

By-law for a diverse metropolis

In accordance with the ministerial orders (2020-00, 2020-033, 2020-049 and 2020-074) adopted in light of the public health emergency related to COVID-19, and following the adoption of resolution [CM19 0784](#) (in French) by city council, the city will hold a written consultation to replace the public meeting required under the Act respecting land use planning and development, in order to solicit questions from the public on draft by-law P-19-041 titled *By-law to improve the supply of social, affordable and family housing (19-041)*.

The written consultation is part of an ongoing public consultation process led by the Office de consultation publique de Montréal (OCPM) for the same purpose, under section 83 of the Charter of Ville de Montréal, metropolis of Québec (CQLR, chapter C-11.4). The OCPM published its report (in French) and recommendations on May 14, 2020. The new version of the by-law was presented following the tabling of the OCPM's report.
