

By-law for a diverse metropolis

In accordance with the ministerial orders (2020-00, 2020-033, 2020-049 and 2020-074) adopted in light of the public health emergency related to COVID-19, and following the adoption of resolution CM19 0784 (in French) by city council, the city will hold a written consultation to replace the public meeting required under the Act respecting land use planning and development, in order to solicit questions from the public on draft by-law P-19-041 titled By-law to improve the supply of social, affordable and family housing (19-041).

The written consultation is part of an ongoing <u>public consultation process</u> led by the Office de consultation publique de Montréal (OCPM) for the same purpose, under section 83 of the Charter of Ville de Montréal, metropolis of Québec (CQLR, chapter C-11.4). The OCPM published its <u>report</u> (in French) and recommendations on May 14, 2020. The new version of the by-law was presented following the tabling of the OCPM's report.
