Notice is given that a special city council meeting will be held as follows:

Date **Wednesday, December 9, 2020, at 2 p.m.**

Place Lucien-Saulnier building, council chamber
155, rue Notre-Dame Est
(Champ-de-Mars metro station)

Due to the public health emergency currently in effect and the special measures taken to limit the spread of the coronavirus, all city council meetings will be held behind closed doors until further notice. Accordingly, council members will attend the meetings by teleconference.

Consequently, the public will not be admitted to city hall during the next city council meeting. However, the meeting may be viewed via webcast (a live stream or recording).

The special meeting of **December 9, 2020**, will mainly deal with the adoption of the city's ten-year capital works program for 2021-2030 (central city component) and the city's 2021 budget (central city component), as well as the approval of the 2021 budgets of certain paramunicipal agencies.

Please note that the question period and deliberations of this special meeting will deal exclusively with these subjects, in accordance with section 474.2 of the *Cities and Towns Act*.

Residents can also ask elected officials questions by sending them in writing by **11 a.m., on Wednesday, December 9, 2020**, according to the format in the special procedure posted on the December 9, 2020 special city council meeting page on the city's website at **montreal.ca**.

The special procedure will replace the regular public oral question period.
