

PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is given that a special urban agglomeration council meeting will be held as follows:

Date Friday, December 11, 2020, at 1 p.m.

(Champ-de-Mars metro station)

Due to the public health emergency currently in effect and the special measures taken to limit the spread of the coronavirus, all urban agglomeration council meetings will be held behind closed doors until further notice. Accordingly, council members will attend the meetings by teleconference.

Consequently, the public will not be admitted to city hall during the next urban agglomeration council meeting. However, the meeting may be viewed via webcast (a live stream or recording).

The special meeting of **December 11, 2020**, will mainly deal with the adoption of the city's ten-year capital works program for 2021-2030 (urban agglomeration component) and the city's 2021 budget (urban agglomeration component), the 2021-2030 capital works program and 2021 budget of the Société de transport de Montréal, as well as the approval of the 2021 budgets of certain paramunicipal agencies.

Please note that the question period and deliberations of this special meeting will deal exclusively with these subjects, in accordance with section 474.2 of the *Cities and Towns Act*.

Residents can also ask elected officials questions by sending them in writing by **10 a.m., on Friday, December 11, 2020**, according to the format in the special procedure posted on the December 11, 2020 special urban agglomeration council meeting page on the city's website at **montreal.ca**.

The special procedure will replace the regular public oral question period.
