

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS AND SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

Notice is given, according to section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of October 19, 2020:

04-047-215 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)

The amendments to the city's planning program authorize, for the St. James United church site (463, rue Sainte-Catherine Ouest) that the "Convent, monastery, or place of worship" land use designation also be permitted for businesses and office buildings.

Following the public notice published on October 28, 2020, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), by-law 04-047-215 is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of November 28, 2020, and comes into force on that date.
