Public notice is by the present given that at its regular sitting which will be held on January 11, 2021 at 7 p.m., the Borough council will render a decision about the minor exemption to the urban by-laws described hereafter. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the possibility for any interested person to be heard before the Council regarding this minor exemption request is replaced by a fifteen days written consultation, announced by a public notice, in accordance with ministerial order number 2020-049.

Study Place of exemption DM 3002417494 5061, rue Geneviève

The exemption is to allow in H1-3-126 zone, for a detached single-family dwelling:

- a rear setback of 5.64 m instead of the required minimum of 7 m;
- a distance of 1.79 m between the detached garage and the main building instead of the required minimum of 2 m:
- a distance of 0.37 m between the detached garage and the east lot line instead of a minimum distance of more than 1 m;
