

PUBLIC NOTICE ALTERATIONS TO THE 2020-2021-2022 PROPERTY ASSESSMENT ROLL

In accordance with section 43 of the Act mainly to control the cost of the farm property tax and to simplify access to the farm property tax credit (2020, c. 7) and section 75 of the Act respecting municipal taxation (CQLR, c. F-2.1), notice is given of the following:

The property assessment roll of Ville de Montréal, filed on September 11, 2019, for fiscals 2020, 2021 and 2022, was altered by means of a global certificate under the first paragraph of section 43 of the Act mainly to control the cost of the farm property tax and to simplify access to the farm property tax credit (2020, c. 7) to take into account the alterations prescribed by the 2020 edition of the Manuel d'évaluation foncière du Québec for the conversion of information relating to the tax apportionments applicable to units of assessment including immovables included in an agricultural operation registered in accordance with a regulation made under section 36.15 of the Act respecting the Ministère de l'Agriculture, des Pêcheries et de l'Alimentation (CQLR, c. M-14).

All of the alterations were made by means of a global certificate and will have effect as of January 1, 2021.

No application for review may be filed or action to quash or set aside brought with regard to the alterations.
