COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of January 25, 2021:

- 07-053-3 Règlement modifiant le Règlement du conseil de la ville sur la subdélégation de certains pouvoirs relatifs à des équipements, infrastructures et activités d'intérêt collectif identifiés à l'annexe du décret concernant l'agglomération de Montréal (1229-2005, 8 décembre 2005) (07-053)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning the subdelegation of certain city council powers relating to facilities, infrastructures and activities of collective interest listed in the schedule to the Order in Council respecting the urban agglomeration of Montréal (1229-2005, December 8, 2005) (07-053)]
The object of the by-law is to repeal the delegation of the maintenance at Mont-Royal Park's Belvédère Chalet and Beaver Lake Pavilion to Ville-Marie borough.
- 21-006 Règlement sur le programme d'appui à la rénovation de petits bâtiments résidentiels**
[By-law concerning the support program for the renovation of small residential buildings]
- 20-041 Règlement visant à améliorer l'offre en matière de logement social, abordable et familial**
[By-law to improve the supply of social, affordable and family housing]
For residential projects with an area of more than 450 m², the by-law requires that an agreement be entered to with the city on the supply of housing before a building permit can be obtained. The by-law contains provisions amending by-laws 11-018 and 19-022. It takes effect on April 1, 2021.
