

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS AND SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

Notice is given, according to section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of January 25, 2021:

04-047-220 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047) The by-law amending the city's planning program amends the list of buildings of heritage and architectural interest located outside areas of exceptional value, for Ahuntsic-Cartierville borough, by removing a portion of the immovable located at 655, rue Sauriol Est (Santa-Rita Church) from the "Places of worship" section. (CM21 0102)

Following the public notice published on February 2, 2021, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), by-law 04-047-220 is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of March 5, 2021, and comes into force on that date.
