

## PUBLIC NOTICE

I give notice that on Tuesday April 6, 2021, at 7:30 p.m., the Saint-Laurent Borough Council will hold a virtual public meeting at the Borough Hall located at 777, boulevard Marcel-Laurin, Saint-Laurent, to rule on **1 request for minor exemption** to by-law number RCA08-08-0001. This exemption request is in addition to the previous two which were the subject of a public notice published in the same newspaper on March 10, 2021.

The minor exemption request concerns the property located at 1040 rue Rochon and relates to the extension of an adjoining single-family dwelling by encroaching on the front setback.

Under Ministerial Decree 2020-049 of July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020, any procedure that involves the movement or assembly of citizens must be replaced by a 15-day written consultation, previously announced by public notice.

Thus, any person can send written comments, by email or by mail, for 15 days following the publication of the notice, so that the board can assess its value before rendering a decision. For any question relating to this procedure please dial (514) 855-6000 ext. 4240.
