PUBLIC NOTICE PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING

The Borough of Saint-Laurent of the City of Montreal will hold a **written consultation** regarding the subject and consequences of the amendment of by-laws **RCA08-08-0001** on zoning. The first draft by-law **RCA08-08-0001-134** was adopted on **April 6, 2021**.

The first draft by-law RCA08-08-0001-134, amending by-law number RCA08-08-0001 on zoning, targets the following provisions:

- Introduce the usage "Data or cryptocurrency processing center";
- Quota the use of "Data processing or cryptocurrency center" in zones I04-001 and I04-012;
- Prohibit the use of "Data processing center or cryptocurrency" in industrial "I" and bifunctional "B" zones located in TOD areas.

Under Ministerial Decree 2021-102 of February 5, 2021, any procedure, other than referendum, which is part of the decision-making process of a municipal body and which involves the movement or gathering of citizens is replaced by a written consultation of 'a period of 15 days, announced in advance by a public notice.

Thus, any person can send written comments, by email or by mail, for 15 days following the publication of the notice concerning the draft regulatory amendments, from **April 8 to April 22, 2021**, so that the council can assess their value before rendering a decision.
