



## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS AND SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

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Notice is given, according to section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of February 22, 2021:

**04-047-218 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)**

The by-law amending the city's planning program amends the "Convent, monastery, or place of worship" land use designation category, with respect to the former presbytery of Saint-Louis-de-Gonzague church (2300, terrasse Mercure), by authorizing the residential use. (CM21 0200)

Following the public notice published on March 1, 2021, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), by-law 04-047-218 is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of April 1, 2021, and comes into force on that date.
