

PUBLIC NOTICE

I give notice that on Tuesday, May 4, 2021, at 7:30 p.m., the Saint-Laurent Borough Council will hold a virtual public meeting at the Borough Hall located at 777, boulevard Marcel-Laurin, Saint-Laurent, to rule on a request for a conditional use on by-law number RCA06 08 0020.

The request concerns a conditional use for the properties located from 491 to 571, boulevard Lebeau and aims to regularize "office use" on the second floor of this industrial building.

Under Ministerial Decree 2021-102 of February 5, 2021, any procedure, other than referendum, which is part of the decision-making process of a municipal body and which involves the movement or gathering of citizens is replaced by a written consultation of a period of 15 days, announced in advance by a public notice.

Thus, any person can send written comments, by email or by mail, for 15 days following the publication of the notice, so that the board can assess its value before rendering a decision. For any question relating to this procedure please dial (514) 855-6000 ext. 4240.
