Public notice is by the present given that at its regular sitting which will be held on June 7, 2021 at 7 p.m., the Borough council will render a decision about the minor exemption to the urban by-laws described hereafter. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the possibility for any interested person to be heard before the Council regarding this minor exemption request is replaced by a fifteen days written consultation, announced by a public notice, in accordance with ministerial order number 2020-049.

The exemption is to allow in H1-7-420 zone, for a projected detached single-family dwelling, an open space ratio (O.S.R.) of 34% instead of the maximum allowed of 30%.
