Public notice is by the present given that at its regular sitting which will be held on June 7, 2021 at 7 p.m., the Borough council will render a decision about the minor exemption to the urban by-laws described hereafter. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the possibility for any interested person to be heard before the Council regarding this minor exemption request is replaced by a fifteen days written consultation, announced by a public notice, in accordance with ministerial order number 2020-049.

The exemption is to allow in H1-7-442 zone, for an extension of the existing detached single-family dwelling, which garage floor is at the same level than the existing, to wit 33 cm above the street center level, instead of the minimum required of 20 cm above the street center level.
