ORDINANCES

Notice is hereby given that the following ordinances were enacted by the Côte-des-Neiges–Notre-Dame-de-Grâce Borough Council at its regular meeting held on May 3, 2021.

BY-LAW CONCERNING TRAFFIC AND PARKING (R.B.C.M., c. C-4.1, article 3)

- Ordinance OCA21 17018 authorizing to add four-way stop signs at the Somerled / Mariette and Fielding / Doherty intersections.

BY-LAW CONCERNING FEES (FISCAL 2021) (RCA20 17343, article 97)

- Ordinance OCA21 17019 authorizing to grant a total reduction of permit review and issuance rates and of fees for the occupancy of public property for purposes of installing a public parklet by a commercial development association or a recognized business association.

BY-LAW CONCERNING COMMERCIAL PROMOTIONS (R.B.C.M., c. P-11 modified by RCA20 17341, article 17.4)

- Ordinance OCA21 17020 authorizing a commercial promotion throughout the borough, until September 14, 2021.

URBAN PLANNING BY-LAW FOR CÔTE-DES-NEIGES–NOTRE-DAME-DE-GRÂCE BOROUGH (01-276, article 515)

- Ordinance OCA21 17021 authorizing temporary signs on public property during the commercial promotional events from May, 4 until September 14, 2021.

BY-LAW CONCERNING PEACE AND ORDER ON PUBLIC PROPERTY (R.B.C.M., c. P-1, articles 3 and 8)

- Ordinance OCA21 17022 authorizing the sale of fruit and vegetables in Nelson Mandela and De la Savane parks and in Place de Darlington by the travelling social market of the Multicaf community cafeteria (MultiCaf) in 2021.
