

PUBLIC NOTICE

I give notice that on Tuesday, June 1, 2021, at 7:30 p.m., the Saint-Laurent Borough Council will hold a virtual public meeting at the Borough Hall located at 777, boulevard Marcel-Laurin, Saint-Laurent, to rule on a request for a minor exemption from by-law number RCA08-08-0001.

The request for a minor exemption concerns the property located at 1373-1375, rue Beaulieu and concerns the expansion of the contiguous two-family dwelling by creating a parking space on the ground floor and encroaching on the side margin of 1,09 m and in the rear setback of 3 m while the applicable regulations require a minimum of 2 m and 7.6 m respectively.

Under Ministerial Decree 2021-102 of February 5, 2021, any procedure, other than referendum, which is part of the decision-making process of a municipal body, and which involves the movement or gathering of citizens is replaced by a written consultation of 'a period of 15 days, announced in advance by a public notice.

Thus, any person can send written comments, by email or by mail, for 15 days following the publication of the notice, so that the board can assess its value before rendering a decision. For any question relating to this procedure please dial (514) 855-6000 ext. 4248.
