

### **By-law for a Diverse Metropolis**

At its meeting on May 17, 2021, city council adopted a draft by-law titled By-law amending the By-law to improve the supply of social, affordable and family housing (20-041).

This draft by-law replaces Schedule B of the By-law to improve the supply of social, affordable and family housing (20-041) with the objective of adding an affordable housing zone 2 to the location corresponding with Lot 1 350 949 of the Quebec cadastre. An affordable housing zone 2 corresponds to an affordable housing requirement of 20 per cent.

In compliance with the rules adopted under the COVID-19 state of emergency, the municipal administration will hold a 15-day public consultation aimed at collecting questions and comments in writing from residents concerning this draft by-law. The written consultation replaces the public meeting required under the Act respecting land use planning and development (LAU).
