

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Commemorations, place names, citations... Montréal takes steps to develop a framework for acts of recognition

The <u>Commission permanente sur la culture, le patrimoine et les sports</u> (the committee) invites the population and interested groups to take part in a virtual public consultation on the city's proposal to adopt a framework for acts of recognition.

By developing such a framework, the city wants to establish guidelines for granting heritage recognitions in the future, to acknowledge, highlight and promote Montréal's values and pluralistic identity.

The consultation involves three steps:

STEP 1 - OBTAIN INFORMATION

The consultation **documents** (in French) are available at <u>ville.montreal.qc.ca/reconnaissance</u>. You can also request to receive the documents by mail, by calling 514-872-3000.

The proposed framework for acts of recognition will be presented during a **virtual information session**, which will be held as follows:

DATE AND TIME: TUESDAY, JUNE 1, 2021, AT 7 P.M.

By videoconference

A link to watch the **webcast of the session** will be available on the day of the meeting at <u>ville.montreal.qc.ca/reconnaissance</u>.

Following the presentation, time will be set aside for the reading of questions and comments from the public, as well as for responses from the city's resource persons or committee members, as the case may be.

Anyone who wishes to **ask a question** or **submit a comment** for the second part of the session is invited to complete the form (in French) available online today at <u>ville.montreal.qc.ca/reconnaissance</u> or contact the standing committees' secretariat by phone at 514-872-3000.

You can also use the same online form to submit a question or comment during the session break, following the presentation.

Step 2 - Submit an opinion to the committee

You can take part in the consultation in two ways:

1- By presenting a brief or an opinion before the committee, during one of the three virtual public sessions scheduled as follows:

Monday, June 21, 2021, at 1 p.m.
Tuesday, June 22, 2021, at 7 p.m.
Wednesday, June 23, 2021, at 9:30 p.m.

You are required to register to present an opinion during one of the sessions. To register, please complete the form (in French) available at <u>ville.montreal.qc.ca/reconnaissance</u> or call 514-872-3000. **The registration deadline is 12:00 p.m. on Monday, June 7, 2021.**
