### **WRITTEN PUBLIC CONSULTATION CONCERNING DRAFT BY-LAW NO.LAS-0146 REGARDING SUSTAINABLE SITE PLANNING AND INTEGRATION PROGRAMS**

**NOTICE** is hereby given to all persons interested that:

Council has adopted, at its sitting of June 7, 2021, a draft by-law bearing number LAS-0146 regarding sustainable site planning and integration programs and repealing by-law LAS-0014. This draft by-law aims to optimize, simplify and improve the site planning and integration regulation process. It also addresses air quality improvement, the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions, the quality of residential living environments, responsible resource management, industrial, commercial and institutional sustainable development as well as the protection of biodiversity, natural habitats and green spaces.

Given the current public health emergency and in compliance with the ministerial decrees relating to procedures other than referendums which are part of the decision-making process of a municipal body and which involve the movement or the gathering of citizens, anyone can submit written comments, by email or by mail for a period of 15 days following the publication of this notice.
