



## PUBLIC NOTICE

### WRITTEN PUBLIC CONSULTATION CONCERNING DRAFT BY-LAW NO. LAS-0145 GOVERNING THE DEMOLITION OF IMMOVABLES

**NOTICE** is hereby given to all persons interested that:

Council has adopted, at its sitting of July 12, 2021, a draft By-law bearing number LAS-0145.

This draft by-law governs the demolition of immovables on the territory of LaSalle in order to:

- Clearly define what is considered a demolition;
- Prohibit the demolition of an immovable except where the owner has been authorized to proceed with the demolition by a committee constituted under this by-law;
- Prescribe the authorization request process;
- Establish the evaluation criteria of an authorization request.

This draft by-law does not contain specific provisions that make it subject to approval by referendum and affects the full territory of the LaSalle Borough.

Given the current public health emergency and in compliance with the ministerial decrees relating to procedures other than referendums which are part of the decision-making process of a municipal body and which involve the movement or the gathering of citizens, anyone can submit written comments, by email or by mail for a period of 15 days following the publication of this notice.
